The specific objectives aim at:  - Strengthened inclusive and sustainable blue economy value chains;  - Ensured integrated approach to sea-land planning and management in a participatory and inclusive manner, especially for women and young people;  - Strengthened effectiveness and integration of maritime law enforcement.		
Brief overview	Go Blue is funded by the EU to unlock the potential of land-sea opportunities in coastal urban centres for sustained, inclusive and sustainable economic growth with employment impact, while conserving and sustainably using the coastal and marine environment as well as promoting effective and integrated maritime governance.
